





2017	Stop and Search	Prohibit the use of non-statutory stop and search.
2017	Stop and Search	End stop of search of children for alcohol.
2019 (enacted 2020)	Equal Protection	Prohibit the use of all physical punishment.
2019 (enacted 2021)	Age of Criminal Responsibility	Raise the minimum age of criminal responsibility.
2021 (yet to be enacted)	UNCRC Incorporation	Ensure UNCRC is directly applicable and justiciable in law.
2021 (yet to be enacted)	Child Rights Impact Assessments	Introduce statutory obligation to conduct CRIA.
Ongoing	Participation	Establish structures for the children's participation in laws, policies and services.
To do	Mosquito Devices	Ban the use of mosquito devices (repeated from 2008).
To do	Religious Observance	Allow children to exercise the right to withdraw from religious worship at school.

Together's 2020 Report

- Suggested 30 topics that UN Committee should include in its list of questions to the UK.
- Drew upon evidence from:
 - 500+ webinar participants
 - 60+ organisations
